FUNDING PURPOSE:

Elevation Programme focuses holistically on the individual and has the total restoration of the person in mind. The objective is to ensure that each person who commences training, completes all the elements to ensure greater success — Life skills, literacy development, skills training, job placement or enterprise development, and self-sustainability.

The past 3 months, we have facilitated the Foundation Programme of two groups of beneficiaries from the funding received.



Beneficiary Reach:

Our target group is unemployed people in the age group 18 – 35 years of age.

We were able to reach 37 beneficiaries that attended the Foundation Programme, 37 attended the Work Readiness Programme.

We have planned to do a foundation course and work readiness programme in Newrest and Paarl East.

All programmes happened as planned with various opportunities that lead us to an impacted community.

We had the opportunity to roll out an additional program in Cape Town - Langa as a Pilot project also that included 21 beneficiaries.

The Elevation Programme has helped me in numerous ways such as finding a better relationship with myself, finding my purpose in life, and understanding my career goals.

I went back to my old working space at in2food, it's a company that prepares biscuits for big companies like Woolworths and Nibbly bits, where I was a general worker, I asked them if I can come back, and they agreed and gave me a month contract.

This time around I wanted to show them that I deserved the second chance, and I am making changes in my life. 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I, Mbalentle is a granny's child, meaning you do all things with a plan and prayer. My mom got me at a young age and my granny took over. She has laid principles in me that I take with me for the rest of my life, she has taught me that when you want something you go for it and u decide. When I heard about the Elevation Programme, I immediately went for it as I was just rejected by NSFAS doing my second semester in Tourism, I didn't want to sit home and do nothing as it would depress me. The first 2 days I got there I felt this was for me until day 3 where I was told you must have a vision in life it started making sense, I realized I had issues I had not delt with.

I started building a relationship with myself and focused on finding my purpose, I forgave my mom because I felt she left me with my grandmother. I started searching the internet for jobs, learnerships and opportunities to study. I joined a program called at home learning, where they help children in school who are struggling to read and have social problems. I am gaining experience, seeing children from different backgrounds and the smiles when they see me, it felt I am giving hope, something I was given as a child by my grandmother I felt I belong.

I feel the Elevation Programme has prepared me for this journey, how they teach you the basics of how you deal with other people and setting boundaries I am now teaching these children how to open up how to allow people in their lives. During our planning for the new year, we decided to explore new communities as we are growing as an organization, and as Employment opportunities grew in the Cape Town area, we visited different communities and we felt at home in Langa, the people, the community, and the organizations there were welcoming. We piloted a project where two stake holders were willing to hold our hands, we recruited and had 21 beneficiaries that joined the program, with the assistance of Langa safety patrol and one of the local churches. We joined a partnership with Love Life and Victory Group where we can continue to mentor these beneficiaries.

18 of the beneficiaries that attended the program already found opportunities through the interventions from Elevation Programme.

Various organizations have heard of the work we do and want to collaborate with us in assisting unemployed youth in the community to grow and develop.


















Monitoring Methods

- Our monitoring process starts where we recruit students. The basic criteria is unemployed youth aged between 18 35.
- Students need to have an attendance rate of 80% at the foundation course.
- We have face-to-face feedback sessions with each student discussing their career path and provide guidance and identify any problem areas.
- We are in communication with students going on training.
- We are monitoring our students on open days with feedback forms as to when they are employed.
- Our database has been updated and with our Field workers in certain areas we have a more reliable follow-up method and communication with our students.
- We facilitate weekly mentoring sessions to make sure our beneficiaries never miss an opportunity.
- Communication is key for us and through establishing this small group support we can really see the difference.
